

Avant STAMP tests are web-based and report scores at benchmarks characterizing proficiency levels similar to the ACTFL Performance Guidelines. STAMP tests:

- engage students in real world scenarios and encourage them to show what they can do with language

- scores for individual students and groups
- are exportable to Excel for flexible analysis
- are available immediately for listening/reading and in three business days for writing/speaking

STAMP tests:

- are realia-based, textbook-independent and computer adaptive
- allow teacher-playback of all student oral-responses and the ability to review written responses
- are statistically validated and externally rated with inter-rater reliability
