

## Spanish Score Interpretation Guide

### Interpreting the Reading and Listening Score Ranges

Within each Benchmark level, Beginning, Transitioning and Expanding, there are designations of A, B and C. These designations identify students in the top third, middle third, or bottom third of the range score for that particular level. Similar to ACTFL's low, mid, and high designations, these designations will assist the classroom teacher in seeing a further breakdown of his students' ability. While they are similar to ACTFL's levels, there is not a direct correlation. Because it takes a great deal of time and practice for students to acquire the skills necessary to move from the Beginning Benchmark to the Transitioning Benchmark, teachers will be able to track student progress within the sublevels of A, B and C.
